

Most Commonly Asked Questions

- May I have permission to use, photocopy, and distribute the PDF materials found on the website?
Yes- For copywrite protection please change the wording to fit your church and agree to use the materials within your church only. You may not reproduce or preprint the materials for profit purposes. We do ask you to send an email statement saying you agree with the provisions and will abide with the request. Once the statement is on file, you may obtain any seminar materials on the Legacy Milestone website.
- Can you send editable versions of the materials?
Unfortunately no, you are welcome to copy and paste from the PDF versions on the website. This will allow you to customize the materials and to refine the wordage to fit your specific needs.
- Do you have PowerPoint presentations for the seminars?
We do use presentations during the Parents Summits however do not have these in formats to send.
- Do you have video recordings of the seminar?
No, we have not recorded the seminars at this time; this may be a possibility in the future.
- Can you send a leaders copy for all materials?
Milestone 1-7 materials are leader/parent friendly. When you read the materials, you will find any blanks are for self-input or conversational input. There is a not separate copy for leaders.
The Faith Talk Seminar will have a leaders copy. This can be found on the website. The first seven pages will have the blanks filled in.
- Is there a cost for the materials?
No- you are welcome to download and use the materials at no charge.
- Can our church use the materials under a different name besides Legacy Milestones?
Yes- please make the milestones personable to your church. Some churches have also found it beneficial to add or decrease the number of milestones. It all depends on where your church is in their milestone walk. Please feel free to use these as a guide and create milestones that will work in your setting.
