Principles of Marriage (1 Corinthians 7)

The questions the Corinthians had about marriage and relationships in 1 Corinthians 7 are no different than the issues that we wrestle with today. The overarching theme behind the Corinthian questions are answered in understanding the guiding principles for biblical marriage.
