



Relevant Church Series: A study of 1-2 Corinthians

Today's topic is a tough one because sexual immorality is a subject the church would rather not discuss. In our culture it is awkward and embarrassing to have even a biblical conversation about sex, biblical standards, and immorality in the church.

The Corinthian church was immersed in a cultural context that valued perversion and immorality even as a form of worship to the goddess Aphrodite. Since the culture was so immoral the church had an opportunity to present a completely different way of life that glorified the One True God.

- 4) How should the church view Christians who refuse to repent choosing a sexually immoral lifestyle? (1 Cor. 5:11-13)

- 5) What should you do when you are tempted with sexual sin? (1 Cor. 6:18)
