Talk is Cheap!

Memorize a short verse with me today. Lead your whole family to memorize the following words...

*“For the Kingdom of God does not consist in talk but in power.”
—1 Corinthians 4:20*

Paul was preparing the people at the church of Corinth for his arrival. He writes to them as they are boasting about their influence, wealth, spirituality, and spiritual gifts. He speaks to them as they analyze their spiritual leadership (Paul, Apollos, and Cephas)... causing divisions in the body.

Paul claims in 1 Corinthians 4:19 that he will find out the truth about these “arrogant Christians.” He will measure them by their power and not by their talk.
