“We serve the world with the Gospel”

Find a quiet moment and sit with your family, a friend, or just by yourself and read the following verses. Matthew 28:18-20 and Matthew 24:14.

According to research called the “Global Status of Evangelical Christianity” there are currently 3,629 people groups in the world that are unengaged and unreached; having no access to the Gospel. These people groups compose a population of approximately 334, 220, 375 people. This is only the population of the world’s people groups who have no access to the gospel. This does not include the lost people residing within the people groups of the world who have access to the Gospel.

1) When you think about those numbers, what feelings do you have as a Christ-follower?

2) As a Christian, when you read Matthew 28:18-20 and Matthew 24:14 what do you think is your personal responsibility to the people of the world?

3) Understanding that you cannot personally take the Gospel to the whole world, what should your commitment be to the Gospel of Jesus in your neighborhood, city, nation, and around the world?

Family or personal prayer walk

Go on a walk with the following assignment:

Ask God in prayer what He would have you do to spread the Gospel among the nations. Be willing to give God control of your life for the sake of the Gospel.
